Trail Director's Report  
2018 AGM**

During the past year there have been many people involved in many important trail projects. Here is a list of some of those projects and some of those people—it is impossible to name them all. Thank-you to all the people who have helped develop and maintain our trails, especially our primary groomers Jasper Asfeldt, Jim Ofirm, John Williams, and Bob Lyons (golf course groomer). Also, a special thanks to Ivar Saugen for maintaining our equipment and Johan Wickers for his work on a number of biathlon range and trail projects.

**Notable 2018 Activities:**

- All trails edges cleared using the new Billy Goat brush cutter. Significant trail width gained.
- Biathlon trail widening project underway. Expect to seed the trails in late May or early June. Trails south of 4-corners (double-bridgeish) closed for the season so the grass can re-establish itself.
- Biathlon range tree planting complete (22 new spruce trees; 4 spruce trees moved).
- New snow fence installed at the top of Heartbreak and on both sides of the trail south of the pumphouse. Fences were effective.
- Berm and bumps completed in the ski playground.
- Double bridge repaired.
- Major clean-up at biathlon range and stadium.

**Summer Projects:**

- Regular trail and equipment maintenance.
- Regular mowing. Jasper Asfeldt will do this.
- Complete biathlon trail widening project.
- Water new trees at biathlon. Murray Lauber will do this.
- Increase height of north berm in the shooting range by one meter.
- Install three new snow fences. Biathlon stadium, biathlon dogleg, upper 7.5 (XC).
